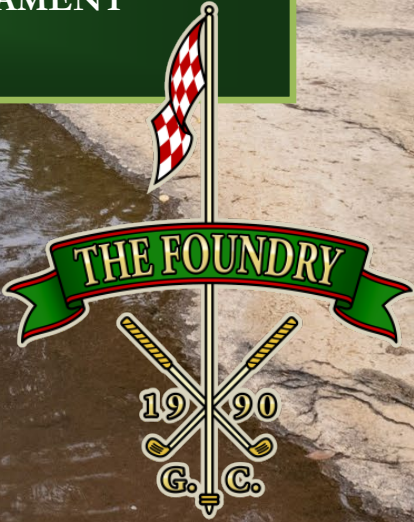

Dear Participant,

Congratulations! We are excited to have you participate in the 35th Annual Foundry Golf Club Member-Guest Tournament. The club looks forward to hosting you for this venerable championship! We are sure you will have a memorable experience!

The field for this year's event is full and has 48 teams signed up! We currently have a lot of teams on the waitlist; if for some reason you and your partner must back out, please let us know as soon as possible.

We are excited to welcome back-to-back defending champion, Paxton Whitmore & Cory Maccumbee. However, we look forward to crowning two new Champions and Shootout Winners this year. The popular Stableford scoring system and Wild Card Teams keep the flights competitive down to the final 9-hole round on Saturday every year. We will be using the same Conditions of Competition as teams will rotate playing opponents and will still have the chance to play 9-holes with the other teams in their flight. Full details on the format are included with this packet and will be explained further at the start of the event.

Please review the following material and schedules. All handicaps for the tournament will be calculated using the WHS's May 1st handicap revision. This will give the staff ample time to create flights and pairings. Changes to handicaps after May 1st will not be used for the tournament. The Foundry Tournament Committee reserves to the right to adjust any handicaps as they see fit.

THE FOUNDRY GOLF CLUB: 35TH MEMBER-GUEST CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

- **Flights** - Teams pre-flighted according to handicap using 100% of their handicap index. 6 teams per flight. Flights determined by team's combined handicap index as of the May 1st revision date.
- **Scoring** - Teams will play five nine-hole rounds with various net medal play formats converted to a Stableford points system. Points will be as follows:
 - Net Bogey – 1 Point
 - Net Par – 2 Points
 - Net Birdie – 3 Points
 - Net Eagle – 5 Points
 - Net Double Eagle – 7 Points
- **Tees** - All tournament participants who qualify for the **70 Rule, 80 Rule and 90 Rule** (Age plus Handicap) will have the option to play “preferred tees” during the tournament, as designated by the professional staff.
 - *Rule 3-5 (players competing from a different set of tees) is now automatically adjusted in your course handicap by the new World Golf Handicap System*
- **Handicap Limit** - Prior to determining tournament flights, teams with partners whose course handicap differential is greater than 10 strokes will be modified. The higher handicap will be adjusted downwards to reflect a tournament maximum differential of 10 strokes. For instance, if a 3 handicap plays with a 14 handicap, then the 14 handicap will be adjusted to 13 for a combined team handicap of 16 (3+13). This team will then be flighted based off of the corresponding team index.
 - *The tournament committee reserves the right to adjust any handicaps prior to the start of competition.*

Formats

• Day 1 – Friday, May 16th

Round One: Best Ball of the team net (converted to points) using 100% of each player's course handicap.

Round Two: Captain's Choice Net (converted to points) w/handicap determined by 30% of team's combined course handicap.

Round Three: Modified Alternate Shot Net (converted to points) using 50% of team's combined handicap. Both players will drive and select one ball to alternate until hole is complete.

• Day 2 – Saturday, May 17th

Round Four: Best Ball of the team net (converted to points) using 100% of each player's course handicap.

Round Five: Combined Net Score (converted to points) of both players using 100% of handicaps.

J.K. Timmons Shootout: Alternate Shot Net Competition – Multiple Hole Shootout.



CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

- **Flight Winners** - Flight winners will be determined by the most combined team points after the completion of Round 5.
- **Ties** - Ties will be decided first by the most team points in the Combined Net format, second by the most team points in the Alternate Shot format, and third by the most team points in the Captain's Choice format. If teams are still tied, then the most points in the best ball format will be used starting with Day 2 and working backwards to Day 1.
- **Wild Card Shootout Exemptions** – The two teams (1 from Flights 1-4 and 1 from Flights 5-8) with the highest combined Saturday point total that do not win their flight will automatically advance to the shootout.
- **Shootout Teams** – All eight flight winners plus the two Wild Card Teams will compete in shootout to determine overall champion.
- **Shootout Format** - Progressive Alternate Shot Shootout with Flights 1-4 and Wild Card A playing the 16th hole with the top 2 teams advancing. While Flights 5-8 and Wild Card B playing the 1st hole with the top 2 teams advancing. Ties for the first shootout hole will be broken by a chip off. Teams that advance will be paired together on the 18th hole which will be converted to a par-5 with the practice putting green making the hole. Teams will have the player who didn't tee off the first shootout hole hit the tee shot, then alternate until the ball is holed. A sudden death format will be used once play starts on hole #18. Players will alternate hitting the tee shot in the sudden death format if teams are still tied after playing #18. We will keep playing #18 until a champion is crowned.
 - Tees for the Shootout- players will tee off from the same tees they played throughout the tournament and players will alternate shots until the ball is holed.
 - Handicaps for Shootout- Team handicaps will be 50% of their combined handicap. Strokes will fall on the respective stroke holes.
- **Prizes** - First and Second Place prizes in each flight will be paid out. See below for more details.

Buy In:	\$200 per Team – Paid in cash and collected during Thursday's Practice Round
Flight Purse:	\$1,200 per Flight
Distribution:	\$700 Flight Winner- Team Payout \$300 Flight Runner-Up – Team Payout (\$200 from Each Flight goes into "Shootout Purse")
Shootout Purse:	\$1,600 – (8 Flights x \$200)
Distribution:	\$600 Shootout Winners – Team Payout \$1,000 – Paid out to other 5 Teams within Flight*

**If the Shootout winner comes from your flight, your team will receive the \$200.00 buy-in back!*

Rules Sheet

- Format:** Individual Stroke Play – Team Skins and Deuce Competition
- Scoring:** Players are responsible for marking their gross score on each hole
Scorecards must be returned to the scoring area under the tent following the completion of your round.
- Buy-In:** \$60.00 per team – cash collected prior to Practice Round
- Skins Game:** Gross and net skins will be paid
- Deuce Pot:** All gross 2's will be paid.
1/3 of all money collected will go into net skins game
1/3 of all money collected will go into gross skins game
1/3 of all money collected will go into deuce pot

Lift, clean, and place in your own fairway

- Tee Markers:** All tournament participants who qualify for the **70, 80, 90 Rule** (Age plus Handicap) will have the option to play “preferred tees” during the tournament, as designated by the professional staff.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- **Caddies** – There are no requests for caddies in Member-Guest. In order for every team to have quality service, caddies will be assigned to a specific flight and work on a rotation basis to cater to every golfer's needs. Our goal is to have enough caddies to have one forecaddie assigned to every 4-some.
- **Practice Round Tee Times** – Please remember that all groups must make a tee time for the practice rounds. If you and your partner do not have another team to play with, the Professional staff reserves the right to pair you with another team to make a complete four-some.
- **Tica Sport Gift Packages** – Please make sure to pick up your Tica Sport gift package at registration on Thursday. If you have yet to fill out your package, you may visit the microsite by [clicking here](#).
- **Rain Date** –We have blocked off Sunday, May 18th as a rain date should we need one. This will help allow us to complete all scheduled rounds if weather does not cooperate with us like in previous years! Our goal is to crown a new championship team playing the competition in its entirety.
